

How To Grow A Plant



Growing plants is fun. You can grow one too. These steps will help you.

You will need:

- Seeds.
- Soil.
- A small pot.

What to do:

Put the soil into a pot. Make sure there is some space at the top.

Place a seed on the soil. Sprinkle soil onto the seed.

The seed needs water. Do not use too much. Plants need a little bit of water each day.

Plants need sunlight. Put your plant near to a window.

See how tall it is with a ruler. Do this every day. Write it down. See how quickly it grows.

Try different seeds. Do they grow the same?
