V: Which word tells you how everything looked?

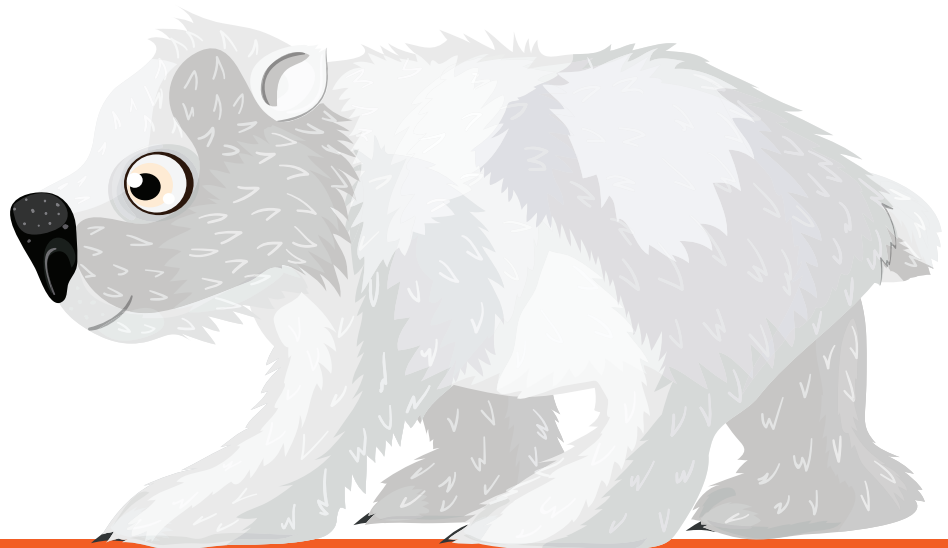
Dazzling Snow Distance
