

How To Ice Fish

People who live in the Arctic like to hunt fish. The lakes are often frozen. Ice fishing is an easy way to catch fish. It works well on a frozen lake. This is how you ice fish.

You will need:

A spear.

Something to dig a hole in the ice. Your spear can do this.

A decoy. This is made of wood. It is made to trick the fish.

Instructions:

1. Find a spot on the ice.
2. Dig a small hole in the ice. It must be big enough to reach into. Use your spear to dig the hole.
3. Attach the decoy to some string. Coat your string in wax. This stops it from freezing.
4. Lower the decoy into the hole.
5. Wait quietly.
6. A fish will bite the decoy. Spear the fish. You can reach in and grab the fish if you don't have a spear.
7. Cook the fish for your dinner.
