

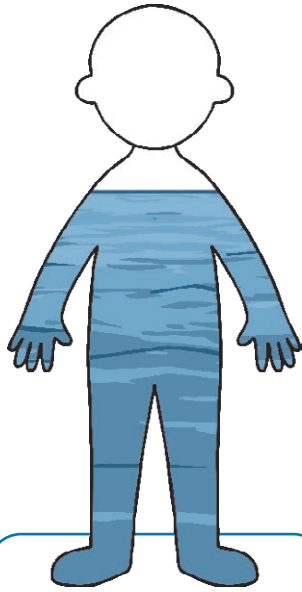
World Water Day 2021

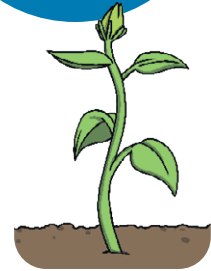

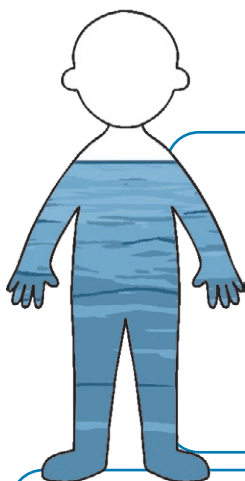

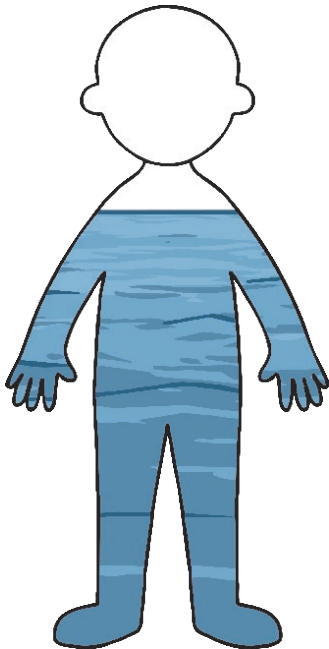
World Water Day happens every year on 22nd March.

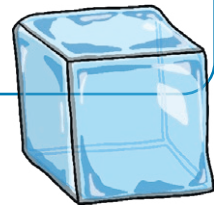
This Year's Theme

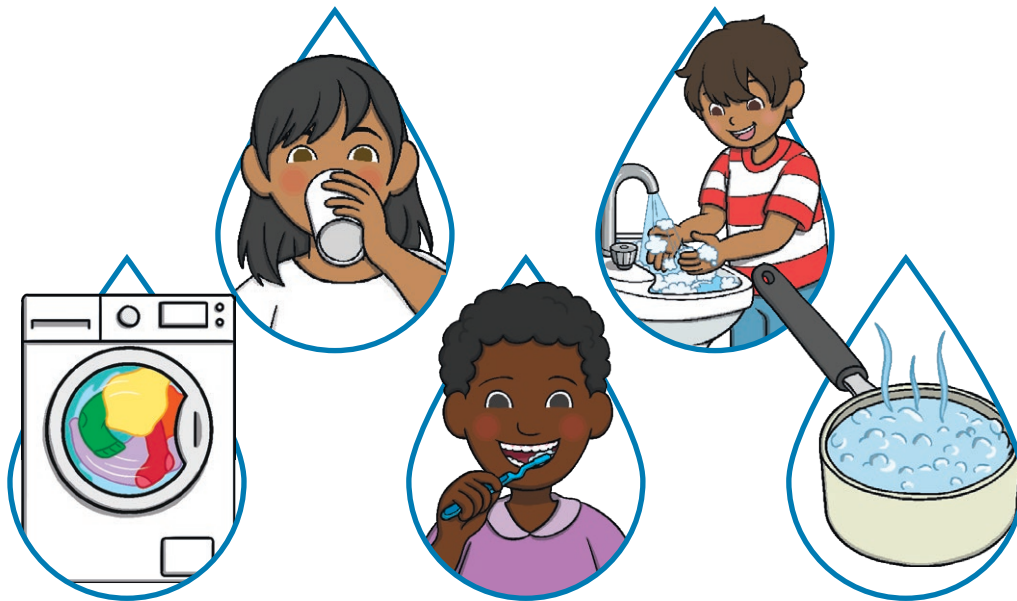
