



Halloween jobs

This week (and during half term) you might like to try some of these jobs.

- Find 8 pegs and cut out a cardboard body of a spider, clip the pegs onto the body and count them, your grown up could write numbers on the pegs, can you put them on in order?
- Make playdough potions, spiders, frogs, witches, ghosts – 2 cups of flour, 1 cup of salt, 1 cup of water and a splash of oil and a drop of food colouring and scent if you'd like.
- Find a large bowl and put spooky things inside to make a witch's potion, you might like to use a mixture of water and cornflour with a drop of food colouring to make a gloopy potion.
- Play Halloween Hide and Seek. Find toys or draw pictures eg frog, slime, snake, eyeball, spider. Make a tally chart. Hide your toys around your house and then ask your family to search for them, they could tick off on the tally chart when they've found them. How many spiders did you find? Did you find more frogs than snakes?
- Make pumpkin soup, there are lots of delicious recipes to search for on the internet, or maybe you could find one in a magazine or recipe book.
- Draw a broomstick, or make one with lolly sticks, draw and cut out creatures to ride on your broomstick. How many can you fit on? If 1 fell off, how many are left?
