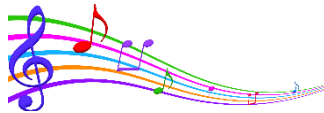

- Watch Mrs Dixon share the story of 'Daniel in the lions' den' tell your grown up what happened in the story.

Floating & Sinking

Let's find out which things float and sink. You can do this in the sink or the bath.

1. Choose some items/toys that won't be spoilt if they get wet
2. Make a prediction (a good guess) will the object float or sink?
3. Put it in the water to check to see if you are right
4. Make a record of things that float or sink to send to your teacher - this could be a list or a set of pictures.

If you want more activities to do at home, look further down the Home Learning page of the website to see ideas from last lockdown. There are also lots of programs on CBBC/CBeebies you can use to support learning at home.

Please remember that children learn lots through play, especially if you can play alongside and/or with them. They will love you reading to them, playing games with them and exploring the outdoors with them.

Reception aged children learn best when they only have to focus for a short period of time e.g. between 5-15 minutes. It is OK for them to have regular play breaks. It is better to stop an activity if it isn't going well and go back to it later rather than battling on and getting stressed.
