Please remember that children learn lots through play, especially if you can play alongside and/or with them. They will love you reading to them, playing games with them and exploring the outdoors with them.

Reception aged children learn best when they only have to focus for a short period of time e.g. between 5-15 minutes. It is OK for them to have regular play breaks. It is better to stop

an activity if it isn't going well and go back to it later rather than battling on and getting stressed.
