

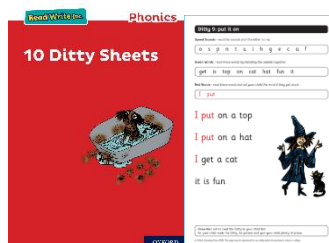
If we were at school children would have one Read Write Inc book per week to read at home. The same applies to the e books.

Orange group read Red Ditty book 'Get-up!'

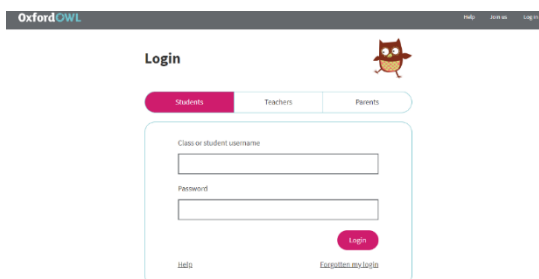
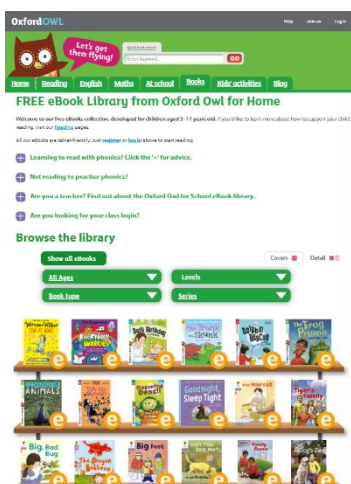
