Reading & Writing:

- Choose a story to read every day.
- Letters to learn - v, y, w, z, x.
- Practise writing the letters using the letter formation rhymes.
- Practise re-telling the story of The Little Red Hen with actions. Change the characters and what is found to make a new story - make up some actions for your new characters.
- Find some rhyming words e.g. hat, cat, mat/ log, dog, fog.

Maths:

Sing some number songs - 1,2 buckle my shoe <https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-one-two-buckle-my-shoe/zkvtqp3> The days of the week song (to The Adams Family Tune)

- Practise counting forwards and backwards to 20, starting at different numbers.
- Practise reading numerals 0-20
- Sequence numerals 0-10

- Compare how much something weighs - hold 2 objects, 1 in each hand e.g. a stone and a feather - which is heaviest/lightest? Why not do some baking and help weigh the ingredients?
- Compare length - make some lego/duplo sticks and order them from shortest to longest - which is the longest, which is the shortest?
- Can you make some Repeated Patterns e.g. stone, leaf, stone, leaf? Spoon, spoon, fork, spoon, spoon, fork. Clap hands, touch knees, clap hands, touch knees. Think of your own. Can your grown up make a pattern for you to continue?
- Play a game of dominoes - can you see and match the patterns?

PE & Music and Movement

- Explore moving in different ways e.g. running, skipping, galloping, hopping, side stepping
- Can you move in different ways to the Animal Boogie song?
