Year 3: Standard English Bingo

Grammar game resource pack

This pack contains a bingo game that is perfect for small groups to revise an activity or as part of an intervention. Once the resource is created, it can be used time and time again to rehearse this skill.

Pupils will revisit using Standard English forms for verb inflections. You may wish to revisit how and when Standard English should be used (rather than local spoken forms) prior to playing the game. Pupils could look at the caller cards and discuss how this would be written using Standard English before playing bingo.

The pack contains:

Bingo caller cards

These cards should be cut out so that cards can be picked at random to be called out.

Bingo cards

10 bingo cards are included. Each card has 9 sentences, written using Standard English.

How to play

- The caller picks a card and reads this out loud. This will be a sentence written using non-Standard English. This could be an adult or a pupil.
- Pupils should check their bingo cards for the same sentence, but using Standard English. Counters could be used for this so that the bingo cards can be used again.
- If a pupil covers words in a row horizontally, vertically or diagonally they can call out "Line!". The game could then continue.
- If a pupil covers all of the words on their bingo card, they can call out "House!" and win the game.
