 - There are lots of fun activities to try on cbeebies, you can meet the three bears, Goldilocks and her friends

 - Goldilocks walks through a wood, maybe your grown ups would take you for a walk in the woods, you will hear different birdsongs. When you get back home, see if your grown up can help find out which you might have heard.

 - Talk about the story, should Goldilocks have walked into the bear`s cottage? Would you leave the door unlocked at your house? If you broke something, what would you do? Why were the bears angry? When have you felt like this?
 - Retell the story using things around your home. Can you match the sizes of items together - all the smallest things together etc?
 - The number 3 is important in the story. Find sets of 3 things around your home, 3 plates, spoons, pans. When you`ve collected as many as you can, count how many you have altogether, it will be a big number!
 - Goldilocks uses good descriptive words such as `soft`, `hard`, `scratchy`. Go on a `Scavenger Hunt` to find something that matches these words.
 - Make porridge with your grown up. Check who likes what flavour - who likes chocolate spread, jam, sugar, syrup mixing in?
 - Have a teddy bear`s picnic in your garden. Decide what the bears might like to eat, lay a blanket and serve them. Your grown up may let you use real food, or you could make playdough food. Mix 2 cups of flour, 1 cup of salt, 1 cup of water and a drop of oil together to make the dough mixture
 - Write a letter to Goldilocks to invite her to your house for tea. Look through magazines, papers, take away flyers to find tasty food she might like to try.

 - Find different types of homes while you go for a walk or bikeride such as bungalows, flats, houses, caravans. What type of home do you live in?
