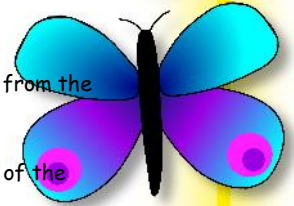
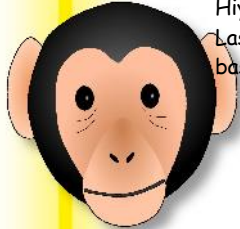


Walking Through The Jungle

- Watch the story **Walking Through The Jungle** being read, try to keep the beat of the story <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kUEw7ZReZL8>

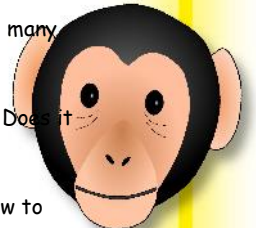
- Listen to the jungle song <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=o332s5Hl0c-song>



- Talk about different types of animals, which are wild? Where do they live? What do they eat? What sound do they make? How do they move? Can you copy their noises and movements? Try a sound and see if your grown up can guess the animal you're pretending to be.

- Think of an animal for each letter of the alphabet

- Find toy animals, line them up on your sofa, play number games eg- 1 *swam* away, how many left? 1 *crept* away, how many left? 1 *swung* back, how many now?



- Put the toys in a pillowcase, reveal just a tiny part of them, guess which animal it is. Does it have spots? Stripes? Feathers?

- Make a paper plate snake -cut a spiral shape, decorate your snake, hang it in a window to scare your grown ups!

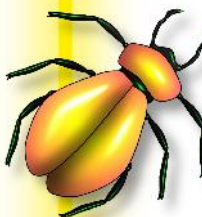


- Make cardboard tube binoculars to search for jungle animals. Hide your jungle toys for your family to find around your house. You might want to give them clues where they are hiding.
