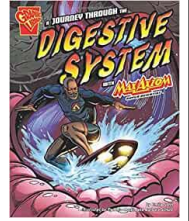

ENGLISH – A Journey Through the Digestive System (Re-telling the story)

This is week 2 of 2 of our English, based on the comic style book 'A Journey Through the Digestive System'. This can be found as a PDF file (you will only need part 1 for re-writing the story)



Week 2 of 2

This week, you will be re-writing Max's journey inside Daisy's digestive system as an adventure story – not in the comic book style it is currently in!

Lesson 1 – Features of a good story

Firstly, read through the story example. This will show you what a good one looks like. Highlight or underline the following features (in different colours, if you can):

- Third person (Max/he/him/the scientist)
- Past tense (doing words ending in -ed /was/knew/could/heard/saw, etc.)
- Fronted adverbials (sentence starters that tell you when, where or how something is happening) They are at the beginning of a sentence and are separated from the rest of the sentence by a comma.
- Powerful verbs (interesting action words)
- Expanded nouns (adjectives to describe Max's surroundings)

Lesson 2 – Fronted Adverbials

This is one of the features of a good story. Practise using a range of fronted adverbials on the Lesson 2 worksheet.

Lesson 3 – Expanded nouns

This is one of the features of a good story. Practise using a range of expanded noun phrases on the Lesson 3 worksheet.

Lesson 4 – Writing your story

Use the story example AND the story word bank to help you write your story.

There should be 6 paragraphs to your story:

Mouth, oesophagus, stomach, intestines, colon, rectum (and out!)

Try to write paragraphs 1,2 and 3 today.

Lesson 5 – Writing your story

There should be 6 paragraphs to your story:

Mouth, oesophagus, stomach, intestines, colon, rectum (and out!)

Try to write paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 today.
