From the Reading & Writing folder:

- Choose a story to read everyday
- Do a Read Write Inc session
- Practise your handwriting - can you think of words that rhyme with cat? Here is a start - cat, mat, fat. Have a go at writing them - look at the sheet in your home learning pack for letter formation. Now find words that rhyme with *jog* and *bin*.
- Read the story again of "The Amazing Adventures of Max" and do the activities on pages 19 to the end of the booklet.

From the Maths folder:

- Watch a Numberblocks episode.
- Do the White Rose maths activities from Summer term - Week 8 folder - Princess Mirror-Belle.
- Sing your favourite number songs.
- Have a go at some 'Beat the Clock' activities.
- Practise writing your numbers, how many can you write in words? E.g. 3 - three.

From the Science folder:

- Keep adding to your bean diary - How big is your bean? Has it got roots and a shoot? Draw a picture of what it looks like.
- Try 'The Magic Dancing Milk' experiment.

From the Activities folder:

- Art Activities - Activity 5 - Creating leaf, stone, wall and bark rubbings.
- Movement - Activity 6 - Colander hedgehog or flower arrangement.
- Make up your own 5-minute exercise routine. What will you include?
