

Magic Dancing Milk by Mess for Less

Drawing on the magic of soap, dancing milk can demonstrate to children how different substances can react to each other. Plus, the wonder of the movement in the tray will have all the children entranced.

What you need:

- A shallow dish or tray (foil trays are fine)
- Food colouring
- Milk
- Toothpicks
- Soap



How you do it: You'll need a shallow dish, such as an empty pie dish or baking tray. Submerge the bottom by pouring room temperature milk into it. Add a few blobs of food colouring (the children can do this part) and then hand each child a toothpick dipped in dish soap - and watch the colours dance.
