### From the Reading & Writing folder:

- Choose a story to read everyday
- Do a Read Write Inc session
- Practise your handwriting - can you write some of the words in the books you've been reading? - look at the sheet in your home learning pack for letter formation rhymes
- Read our story called 'The Amazing Adventures of Max' and do the activities on pages 9-13 in the booklet.

### From the Maths folder:

- Watch a Numberblocks episode
- Have a go at some of the addition and subtraction games on 'the maths factor' website <https://www.themathsfactor.com/topics/>
- Sing your favourite number songs
- Practise finding groups of even and odd numbers - check the socks in the washing basket, the number of toys on your bed, windows in your house etc
- Can you use some of the objects you found last week e.g. stones, leaves to make a repeating pattern? E.g. stone, leaf, stone, leaf OR leaf, leaf, stone, flower, leaf, leaf, stone, flower
- Practise writing your numbers and put them into groups of odd and even numbers - what do you notice about all even numbers?

### From the Science folder:

- Keep adding to your bean diary - How big is your bean? Has it got leaves? Has it got flowers? Draw a picture of what it looks like.
- Have a go at the 'Melting' Science activity
