Task 1: make adverbs from these adjectives.

Examples: horrible = horribly

adorable = adorably

Task 2: make sentences using the new adverbs.

Don't forget punctuation!

Examples: The little girl brushed her new doll's hair adoringly. Or: Adoringly, the little girl brushed her new doll's hair.

This task is going horribly wrong! Or: Horribly, this task is going wrong!

Challenge: can you write sentences which use both the adjective and the adverb?

Example: The terrible game was played terribly.

Top Tips: remember that adjectives describe nouns and adverbs describe verbs.

Experiment with the position of the adverb in the sentence; what do you notice?
