Adding -ful

We can add the suffix **-ful** to make new words too.

- Adding **-ful** changes a noun to an adjective (a describing word for a noun).

For example: **joy** becomes **joyful**.

There's a **spelling rule** for adding the suffix **-ful** too.

- If the word ends in a **consonant + y**, change the **y** to an **i** before you add **-ful**.

For example: **beauty** becomes **beautiful**.
