- Pupils should find as many examples of artefacts that symbolise Brazil.

Create a symbolic piece of artwork to depict Brazil

- The aim is to create something unique that captures Brazilian culture.
- You will need to use your sketch books in the first instance to try out some ideas.
- It would be very useful to keep a record of how you came to your final piece of art work.
- Your final piece must be a something that you are proud of. It should be contemporary, modern art.
- However, your final piece must immediately tell someone that your subject is Brazil.
- When you have completed your work you will be involved in evaluating others' work and yours will be evaluated by at least two other peers.
