### Uniform Reminder for Summer Term

As we move into the warmer months, we'd like to remind pupils and families about our uniform expectations. **Skirts and shorts must be of an appropriate length (mid-thigh or longer)**, maintaining a respectful and practical standard for school activities. **Crop tops are not permitted**, all tops should cover the midriff. **Flip flops are not permitted** for safety reasons. **Crocs** are allowed, but they must have a **strap around the back of the heel** to ensure they stay secure. **With the sun shining**, please remember to **bring a hat** - make sure it is clearly named. We also encourage pupils to **bring sunscreen**, which should be labelled with their name to avoid mix-ups. If your child is wearing inappropriate clothing for school, please be aware that they will be asked to change into something from our uniform spares. Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe, comfortable, and ready to learn!
